## **Draft normal resolution**

## Rule of law in international relations (was Putins' security analysis)

**Tabled by** De Groenen (the Netherlands) amended by Les Verts, Green Russia, GroenLinks, Die Grünen and the EGP Committee

 The Greens see article 2 of the Charter of the United Nations, which states that all members shall settle their international disputes by peaceful means and shall refrain in their international relations from the threat or use of force against the territorial integrity or political independence of any state, as a corner stone of international public order. The United States violate this principle with their threat of violence against particularly Iran, Syria and North-Korea. With their threat the United States incite fear within those nations and this fear is a major cause for nuclear proliferation.

The European Greens condemn the aggression of the United States and call on all European governments to refrain from military or political support for any military action which misses an explicit mandate from the Security Council.

**Clarification**: this is a straightforward effectuation of one of our principles as stated in the Charter of the EGP.
